A: You can create a brand new user account with a new email address and password, and that should allow you to use it with the other email address you used previously. If that doesn't work, you might have to contact your ISP to have your old email address deleted. Lastly, if you are using an email provider like gmail that is hosted on their servers, you can try to delete your old account with your other email address and sign up again with that address.
