User interface in AutoCAD is customizable, allowing users to set preferences to their liking. New Features New features are being developed for AutoCAD 2017, but not everything can be included with every update. The following features have been announced: 3D Visualization 3D modeling and rendering are now available in AutoCAD as an improved version of 2D rendering. In AutoCAD 2017, objects can be modeled in 3D and then viewed in 3D, edited in 3D, and printed from 3D. You can view your models in 3D from a 2D view, and edit models from a 2D view. Features in 3D will allow you to move, rotate, and scale models in 3D. The 3D model of an object is stored in the “3D Model” block. Light Tracing AutoCAD 2017 has light tracing functionality. Light tracing allows you to see the lighting effects of one object on another. New Dynamic Input Panel Improvements Dynamic Input Panel is a feature that has been available in AutoCAD since version 2010, and has evolved significantly since that time. In AutoCAD 2017, the Dynamic Input Panel can be used to control input operations. It has a fixed button layout that provides a more familiar and easier to use interface than the older version of the Dynamic Input Panel. Dynamic Input Panel can also be used to customize and personalize input tools. New Options AutoCAD 2017 has new options available for customization of the user interface: AutoCAD Wall System The AutoCAD Wall System allows you to create walls and automatically create base edges for

them. Solid Canvas Solid Canvas allows you to create textures and add strokes to them. Custom Line Pattern The new Custom Line Pattern will allow you to add a custom line pattern to the surface of objects and blocks. Text/Object Color Chooser The Text/Object Color Chooser allows you to select colors for text and objects in drawings. Filename format Autodesk maintains a proprietary file format for CAD data, called drawing exchange format (DXF). Originally called Draftit, Autodesk Corporation developed it in response to the increased demand for 2D drawings that could be viewed with AutoCAD. When 2D drafting began its decline, it was rebranded to incorporate its object-based nature. CAD data is created and represented in a hierarchical format, where the objects (lines, polylines, circles, text, etc.) are what is used in creating the data. In response to the need to view all levels of the hierarchy, Autodesk implemented DXF, which allows for a flat listing of both objects and their attributes. Drawings A drawing file is used for plotting three-dimensional objects on paper or other media. Drawings are commonly created using a type of industry-standard file format for these objects, the AutoCAD Drawing Exchange Format (DXF), along with image-based CAD programs that can produce them, such as the widely used Autodesk Architectural Desktop or AutoCAD LT. There are two kinds of CAD files: Drawing files Drafting Exchange Format (DXF) files Drawing files and DXF files have the same basic structure, but they have many differences. Drawing files are typically described as "object-based", where each object is represented in the file in its own entity record. DXF files use a "flat" structure, where objects are listed together, rather than as separate entities. A DXF file can contain many objects, and often the only way to view the hierarchy of the file is to open the DXF file in its own tool. Drawing and DXF files are often combined with image-based programs in order to create physical images, particularly when doing detailed, precise work. Other drawing file formats are also available, such as the DGN and PDF formats. The DGN format is a proprietary format, available from DGN.autodesk.com, that is mostly used for

its compatibility with AutoCAD. The PDF format is an open industry standard for raster graphics. Other drawing file formats include NX (by FormZ Corporation), which is a native file format, and DWG (by Corel, available for purchase from Corel Corporation). Drafting Exchange Format (DXF) files are a standard drawing file format used by many CAD programs, such as Autodesk Architectural Desktop or Auto a1d647c40b
