Two survivors of the plane crash on Bali's east coast have been transferred to hospital, while residents have pulled the bodies of others from the wreckage. The plane crashed near a beach in Seraya, north-east of the island's capital, Denpasar, killing all 62 people on board. The aircraft was travelling from the Indian city of Gaya to Singapore.
The jet's pilot had sought permission to turn back after realising he was descending too low, and the pilots of two other planes have been arrested. "We are still trying to control the fires in the plane crash site. We have also recovered two bodies at the time," said Tanjung Priok police chief Hery Andriyanto. The survivors include a French woman who was sitting in one of the rear-facing seats of the Airbus A320, Indonesian national airline Lion Air has said. She was taken to hospital by the US military and is now in stable condition. The pilot of the other plane, an Iranian national, is recovering in hospital. The plane's two pilots, an Indian and an Indonesian, were arrested for not following international rules. One witness, Paramitha Banaget, said he was about 600m (yds) away when he saw the plane plunge into the sea. "The plane came in very low and then we saw a big sound that was a huge thump," he said. "I heard the sound of the bodies hitting the ground." The pilot had filed a request to return to the base after noticing the plane's altitude was lower than acceptable, but did not immediately
